

Sgt Dan GOAT PELLETS are formulated to support metabolisable energy intake in goats for fattening or milk production. Produced using a combination of New Zealand grown grains and palm kernel meal as well as added macro and trace minerals, **Sgt Dan GOAT PELLETS** provide a cost effective alternative to low quality forages.

When fed at 250g per head per day this diet provides

- 85mg zinc
- 20mg copper
- 1mg iodine
- 1.4mg cobalt
- 0.5mg selenium
- Vitamins A, D3 and E

Recommended feeding rate:

Feed **Sgt Dan GOAT PELLETS** in conjunction with *ad lib* pasture or silage, introducing the pellets gradually and building up to target feed intakes over one to two weeks.

- Feed between 200-500g per head per day depending on the type, sex, size and age of goats, expected performance and forage availability and quality.
- Always feed in conjunction with ad lib pasture or silage.
- Ensure that fresh clean water is available at all time.
- Ensure adequate feeding space is provided for all animals to access pellets simultaneously to prevent over consumption.

For optimal growth of kids, supplement with **Sgt Dan SUPER LAMB** from 3 days until weaning.
